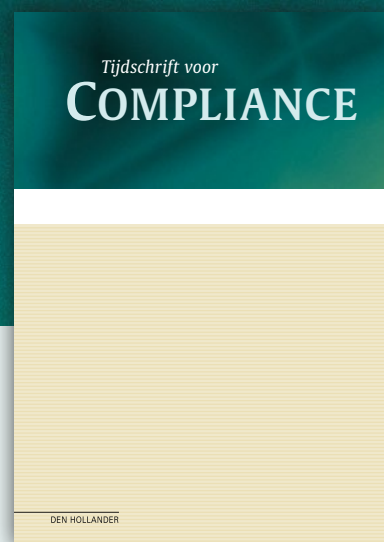

Submission Guidelines

- Proposals to write an article on any of the topics above can be submitted to the editorial board via email (redactie@tijdschriftvoorcompliance.nl) by the deadline as detailed above. Submissions and articles can be written in Dutch or in English.
- The proposal would include a short abstract describing the gist of the article or a draft of the article (if ready), as well as a short bio and contact details of all authors.
- Our editorial team aims to get back on each proposal within 10 working days. When relevant, the editorial team will share with the author further information with respect to submission and article publication deadlines.
- The journal is not committed to publish any article, even when the proposal was accepted by the editorial board. Each final article will be reviewed by the editorial board, who has the sole discretion to decide on publication.
